

Continuous Professional Development (CPD) Courses

By 2016 it will be compulsory to obtain 30 CPD points per year to remain on the coaching register. The following courses count for CPD points: BI Support, BI Coach Education Qualifications, Irish Sports Council Support, Sport NI Support, Relevant FETAC Courses, Teicnic Levels, Branch CPD Events, First Aid, LSP Courses, and practical coaching hours with a squad or club. BI L1/2* In order to qualify for this, coaches must be working on a regular basis for a specific club or branch squad, and hold the coaching level qualification specified above.

FETAC Level 5/6/7* Points are awarded for each module most courses comprise of 7-10 modules. Example courses: FETAC Level 6 complete course can total 50 points: FETAC Level 6 component Certificate in Sports Nutrition, FETAC level 5 course: FETAC Level 5 component Certificate in Exercise and Fitness, FETAC level 7 course: Diploma/BSc in Exercise and Health Fitness. BI Coach Level 1/2* Updating to the new level 1 carries 30 points, and L2 carries 50 points.
